Purpose:

A complete high specification supplement designed to be fed to livestock to fortify hooves and chitinous tissues at times when animals are predisposed to foot abscess and other *Fusobacterium, Necrophorum* and *Actinomyces* infections. It also offers general fortification of minerals, trace elements and vitamins.

Product Appearance:

StockMins-Hoof n Horn appears as a granular, palatable, dry and dust free powder. It is molasses coated and weatherproof. It also has a strong earthy smell.

Target Animals:

Feed free-access to sheep and cattle from ten weeks to a month prior to time of exposure to wet pastures and feed continuously during high risk periods. During lambing continue feeding to ewes and lambs for at least four weeks post lambing. It may also be included in a mixed ration.

Product Features:

- Is fortified with effective acid buffers to reduce the chance of acidosis (SARA).
- Contains the B vitamin, Biotin which has been shown to increase hoof growth and strength.
- Offers livestock high levels of inorganic and organic zinc, with the specific organic zinc included having strong indications for hoof quality and immune response.

Feeding Instructions:

Free Access Feeding: - Offer free access in tubs limiting intake for sheep to around 25g/head/day and cattle to 100g/hd/day once animals are fully adapted. Animals will control their own intake. Use one tub for 50-60 sheep; replenishing supplement as necessary.

Mixed Rations: - Mix thoroughly together with ingredients to make a complete mixed ration at a rate of 25kg of **StockMins-Hoof n Horn** per 1 tonne of feed.
