

Product Information StockMins – BoviBloat Plus

~ Green Feed Supplement for Cattle ~

Purpose:

To assist in the control and onset of symptoms of pasture bloat by direct feeding at pasture or including in feed rations.

Product Appearance:

StockMins – **BoviBloat Plus** is a palatable, molassed, semi granular feed supplement. It appears as a light coffee colour. It is salty to the taste and has distinct sweet molasses smell.

Target Animals:

StockMins – **BoviBloat Plus** should be fed free access or in-feed to cattle grazing in conditions predisposing to frothy bloat such as lush legume and grass pastures.

Product Description:

StockMins - BoviBloat Plus contains a combination of two effective active constituents, Teric PE62 and Bovatec[®] that, in combination, aid in the prevention of bloat development and reduction in bloat symptoms.

Key Features:

- Teric has strong anti-foaming properties even at small levels of intake.
- Bovatec® bloat claim: Aid in the reduction of bloat in cattle on pasture.
- Fortified with calcium, salt, magnesium and trace elements to assist in correcting common deficiencies associated with growing livestock grazing lush green pasture.
- Bovatec® has been shown to boost liveweight gain in livestock grazing green feed by up to 14% (*Zoetis data on file*).

Feeding Instructions:

Recommended Intakes for Cattle:

Animal	Liveweight Range (kg)	Target Daily Intake (g)
Beef Cow	450 - 800	100 - 150
Dairy Cow	550 - 800	100 - 150
Heifers/Steers	350 - 500	75 - 125

Free Access Feeding:

Offer **StockMins – BoviBloat** free access in tubs limiting intake to around 100 - 150g head/day for cattle. Animals will tend to control their own intake.

Use one tub for 30 cows.

Mixed Rations:

Mix thoroughly together with other ingredients to make a complete mixed ration at a rate of 50kg of **StockMins – BoviBloat** supplement per tonne of feed.

StockMins – **BoviBloat** is partially weatherproof. It is advisable to prevent rain from affecting the product where possible. Where rainwater is unavoidable, use tubs (half 200 litre drums or half 20 litre drums) with vertical slits on the sides and holes on the bottom to allow prevent rainwater from pooling.

Caution:

- Only feed to livestock intended.
- Do not allow access to horses!
- Do not feed to sheep!
- Introduce gradually and monitor intakes until intake stability is achieved.
- Do not use in lamb or beef feedlot diets.
